The Principal, Dr. Janardhan Rao Killi organized a lecture on 08.03.2018. The chief Guest Dr. Tanweer Shaikh, Assistant Professor, Department of English, Subhash Baburao Kul Arts, Commerce and Science College, Kedgaon; delivered a lecture on the topic "Language and Literature: Interpretation to Communication".

The chief Guest Dr. Tanweer Shaikh addressed the students on how to develop language skills on their own. His speech was divided into three parts. In the first part, he focused on how to develop the Language skills. In the second part he distributed pictures to the students and he asked them to scrutinize the picture after which they were asked to speak about the picture. Then he compared the act of reading the picture to the act of reading a book viz., first one scans a book, then looks for a specific point and then critically analyzes it. In the last part he covered the recent trends in literature with a special focus on postcolonial theory, binary oppositions and the centre-margin dynamics.




Topic: "BASIC TOOLS OF ENGLISH GRAMMAR"






Spoken English

A legal lecture on "Law of Contracts"

On April 22, 2019, a legal lecture on "Law of Contracts" was held at the law college of the Pune District Education Association. Prof. (Dr.) Vishwanath Patil, the principal of The Shri Shivaji Maratha Law College in Parvati, Pune, gave the lecture.

He began by outlining the role that "Law of Contracts" plays in our daily lives and how it came to be thought of as one of life's most crucial facets. He engaged the pupils in conversation as he explained the significance of this particular location and quizzed them on various aspects of the subject.

Then he went over the fundamental ideas of contracts and the Indian Contract Act of 1872 with the pupils.

He began by stating that the word was derived from the Latin word "contractum" before explaining what a "agreement" was. He clarified for the students the differences between a proposition and its adoption as an agreement. His presentation of this issue of agreement was clear and students paid close attention to what he was teaching since he used a variety of examples to engage them more in what he was presenting.

He went on to explain the differences between contracts and agreements. He explained the meaning behind the well-known adage, "All contracts are agreements, but not all agreements are contracts."

He also discussed the fundamentals of agreement and the three different sorts of contracts—valid, void, and voidable.

He also went into detail with the pupils on the subtle distinction between void and void *abinitio*. He went on to discuss unenforceable contracts and how, even when gained by force, an acceptance could create a contract at the decision of the party who was wronged.

He also spoke on the creation of contracts. What are its core components? What part of a contract does consideration play? What prevents a deal from being a contract?

Students raised questions toward the end of the talk, and Dr. Vishwanath Patil responded. He urged the students to read and learn as much as they could in law school by quoting, "Any knowledge that you possess today would be your asset in future."

There was a lot of interaction during the lesson. Every student at the Law College of the Pune District Education Association learned a lot from the presentation.

Lecture by Dr. Vishwanath Patil

Guest Lecture by Dr. Vishwanath Patil on "Making Law Students Practice Ready" The PDEA's Law College hosted a guest lecture by Dr. Vishwanath Patil on the subject of "Making Law Students Practice Ready" on January 10, 2020 in the Seminar Hall. Dr. Ranjana Patil presided over the presentation. Dr. Patil was asked to introduce the visitor and lay out the lecture's structure after the initial welcome ceremony. After saying this, she gave the group Dr. Wishwanth Patil's address. In his opening remarks, Dr. Wishwanath Patil made reference to the fact that the Indian legal education system generated law graduates without instructing them in the skills necessary for practicing.

As a result, the real clients end up being used as an experimental scapegoat by the young, inexperienced advocates. Although disciplines like Drafting, Pleading, Client Counseling, and Legal Ethics are included in the curricula of Indian law schools, he claimed that very few of them truly teach students how to use these methods in practice. Dr. Patil continued by outlining certain unchangeable abilities required for a law graduate to practice the craft of advocacy. One of these qualities, he highlighted, is having a strong sense of communication. But as he pointed out, what sets a good advocate apart from the competition is the art of listening, not just being a skilled speaker.

He argued that one should have the ability to work with clients and establish a rapport with them. He asserted that an advocate can only appreciate and comprehend the client's perspective by patiently hearing what she has to say. Dr. Patil added that in order to comprehend the legal viewpoint of the issue, an advocate must become an expert in how the facts relate to the law. He told the students that in order to master any case, they must understand how to separate the legal components from the mass of facts. He argued that ethical advocacy was necessary to separate the law from the facts.

He condemned the habit of certain advocates manipulating the facts of a case by saying that when the facts are colored by the advocate's evaluative prejudices, it signals the end of ethical advocacy. The discussion of numerous advocacy strategies, including drafting and witness examination, was then continued by Dr. Patil. The most important advocacy skill, according to him, is to make the point clear and avoid turning it into legalese. He claimed that the only prerequisites for doing so are reason, common sense, and ethics. According to him, only through embracing the virtues of reason, common sense, and ethics is this feasible.

Dr. Patil continued by talking about the expanding role of ADR in the Indian legal system and the different career paths it provides for aspiring lawyers. He made particular mention of the practice of mediation and how advantageous it is for both individuals and the overworked formal court system. Dr. Patil stressed the importance of including the art of advocacy in law education as she wrapped off her talk. He insisted that simply holding mock trials and other such exercises wouldn't prepare recent law graduates for the practice environment. He argued that diverse types of experiential learning must be incorporated into law school curricula in order to improve the nature of our Indian legal education system.

Another excellent presentation came to a conclusion when one of the PDEA's Law College faculty members was finally asked to offer the vote of gratitude.

A guest lecture on "Skills of Advocacy" was presented on February 22, 2021 at the Law College, Hadapsar of the Pune District Education Association.


The invited speaker was Dr. Vishwanth Patil. Dr.Ranjana Patil, the principal of the law college run by the Pune District Education Association, gave the opening remarks. Since the true struggle starts when the case is put on hearing and advocates must face Judges who have many pending files to consider, she explained in her welcoming speech why it is crucial to develop advocacy skills from the beginning. It all comes down to a lawyer's advocacy ability and how he or she approaches the courtroom process using their communication abilities.

Dr. Vishwanath Patil uses a variety of skills to mold students into effective lawyers who are not just knowledgeable but also possess a mastery of language. In his speech to the students, he also emphasized the value of good manners, indepth research, presentation skills, and a firm grasp of the case's facts as elements of successful advocacy. He emphasized how the art of drafting and pleadings aids a lawyer in making a strong case.

Adv. Patil underlined the importance of consistently reading judgments intently with a curious mind in order to identify the strongest forms of arguments. He underlined the value of communicative language used in courtrooms and the need for pupils to grasp it.

Additionally, he spoke on the difficulties young lawyers experience while communicating, speaking in court, preparing, and responding to court questions. The speaker's speech was intelligent, and he used examples from his own experience and real-world situations to illustrate his points.

The students' motivation from the speaker's comments led to the event's overwhelming success. The vote of gratitude was proposed by Mrs. Kazi, the law school librarian at PDEA, and that concluded the talk.

Lecture on Special Contracts (Negotiable Instruments) Held on Date: 23/03/2022

On March 23, 2022, Prof. (Dr.) Vishwanath Patil, the principal of PDEA's Law College, present a lecture on unique contracts, with a focus on the "Negotiable Instruments Act".

He covered the fundamentals of negotiable instruments and key ideas under the Negotiable Instruments Act during the first lecture session. The pupils were genuinely intrigued by his Power Point presentation. almost all drafts of negotiable instruments, including bill of exchange, check, promissory note, and currency formats, as well as structured detail information. On his lectures, he began by discussing numerous issues with Negotiable Instruments and how the Apex courts handled them in order to find answers.

He discovered the many Indian cases involving negotiable instruments. In the meanwhile, he advised the pupils to read the pertinent books and articles as references. He specifically cited Halsbury's Law of India, Volume 4, and instructed the pupils to memorize the text if they wanted to be well-informed about current events. For the purpose of comprehending Negotiable Instruments, he recommended numerous more readings. The topic of criminal responsibility, the potential for compounding offenses, and the potential for additional legal remedies at the moment of disagreement has also been nicely explored.

He focused particularly on the more recent and practical approaches and developments in the law on negotiable instruments during the third segment of his talk.

He took the time to finish the subject's entire relevant syllabus. The most recent updates and cutting-edge strategies for negotiating instruments in the digital age have also been touched on. One of the unique aspects of his three session lectures on Negotiable Instruments was the harmony of the students' natural curiosity and scholastic requirements. He had a formal engagement with the other faculty members as part of curtsy following the completion of all classes. Deputy

The pupils and faculty of PDEA's Law College, Hadapsar gave the honourable guest speaker a warm welcome. In his explanation of the notion of natural law, the guest speaker identified the history of natural law as the history of humans, which has existed since the beginning of time. It refers to those standards and precepts that are believed to have been given by an authority greater than any governmental body.

It is logical to believe that a natural law encompasses several human values such as morality, justice, good behaviour, and so on after reading the foregoing statement. It is a dynamic theory that has evolved over time while taking all relevant socio-economic and political factors into account.

He went on to say that the philosophy is built on two unchanging tenets: first, a universal order that governs all men, and second, the unalienable rights of every person.

The Doctrine of Equality, which is outlined in Article 14 of Part III of the Indian Constitution, relates to the Universal Order ruling all persons. The Indian Constitution's article 13 guarantees each person's unalienable rights, which cannot be altered or curtailed. He outlined the concept of natural law and natural rights. The natural law takes precedence over all human laws and legislative actions. As a result, all kinds of man-made laws are overridden by natural law, which demands adherence. In contrast to other laws, it is not codified. Additionally, it contains no provisions for penalties or punishments if it is broken. He explained the value of the right to privacy in the modern world and how the lashould work.







Guest lecture by Prof. Dr. Vishwanath Patil

The Law College of the Pune District Education Association and Mahatma Phule Institute of Management & Computer Studies hosted a judicial lecture on "Different Perspectives of Law" on April 21, 2018. Prof. Dr. Vishwanath Patil, the principal of The Shri Shivaji Maratha Law College in Parvati, Pune, gave the lecture.

What is Globalization? was the question he posed at the start of his speech. The history of globalization was then covered. He said that Karl Marx was the father of globalization. The best way to define globalization as we currently understand it is as the increased capital mobility caused by the transfer of commodities and services across borders as well as the increased flow of information as a result of technological advancements and the opening up of new markets.

The capitalists of post-industrial nations and those who are just starting out compete with one another by raising profits and reducing expenses, which is a natural phase of capitalist accumulation. But what effects will this procedure have? The political and economic theorist Karl Marx predicted that as capitalism advanced, it would take the form of expanding markets and a bigger flow of products and services.

Dr. Patil went on to explain what law is. How should one view the law? Which branch of science is it? He gave the students an explanation of Manu. Manusmriti, often known as "The Institutions of Manu" or "The Laws of Manu," is the most significant and authoritative Hindu Law Book (Dharmashastra).

He then talked on Law's economic viewpoints after that. He used examples from everyday life to illustrate the importance of the economic perspective in law.

The next topic he covered was perspectives on international law. According to him, "International perspective in law means only pure international law."

He stated that India is in need of attorneys who are well-versed in international legal perspectives and who can represent India in matters involving India on various platforms.

He also discussed how society and the law are related. Society is to blame for the creation of law. Law wouldn't have been necessary if there hadn't been a society. Our lives are governed by the law. Without law, neither we nor our way of life could exist.

He linked Sociology with Law with the help of examples. "Earlier, Joint Family System prevailed but now the concept of nuclear family came into being. The increasing popularity of nuclear families is violating the human rights of senior citizens in India who end up living a lonely life, which in turn has a negative impact on their emotional and physical well-being. To address the problem of elderly people who are suffering, Maintenance and Welfare of Parents and Senior Citizens Act, 2007 came into existence. This happened because of changing behaviour of the society."

Indian society has started to imitate Western society, which has led to this issue. However, Indians are unable to comprehend how fundamentally different the Economic, Political, and Social Scenario of Western Society is from the Indian Scenario.

In terms of culture and other factors, he contrasted Indian society with western society. As a result of our imitation of Western culture, our society begins to experience challenges, which require the application of the law. He demonstrated the significance of the sociological perspective on law using examples from everyday life.

"If we (the Legal Fraternity) can understand law from different perspectives, then we will be able to understand the true essence of law, and only then can we apply it from different perspectives to solve the problems of the real world," he said as he put an end to his lecture.

Traffic Awareness Programme



Hadapsar Traffic Police Rally Promotes Use of Helmets by Women

The Students of PDEA's Law College cooperated with Hadapsar Traffic Police for Traffic police's Road Safety Awareness Week 2024.

Traffic police's Road Safety Awareness Week 2023, aimed at highlighting the importance of helmets, concluded with a two-wheeler rally. PDEA's law college organised two wheeler rally in association with Mahatma PhuleInstitute of Management and computer studies. Around 40 Student two-wheeler riders participated in the rally and displayed slogans on road safety, especially the use of helmets. During the event, reflective tapes were also pasted on helmets of participants. A stringent enforcement campaign is expected to be carried out next against those not wearing helmets.

Traffic police personnel were present at various intersections of the city, distributing pamphlets to create awareness about wearing helmets. They also visited the offices of companies such as Infosys, schools and colleges to reach out to a wider audience.

Why Wear a Safety Helmet?

Components of the Helmet and Their Roles

Typically, a helmet has the following components:

The Shell:

the shell of a helmet is an injection molded thermoplastic or a pressure molded thermo set that is reinforced with glass fibers or made of fiber glass.

It absorbs energy in an impact:

the shell bends when the helmet is impacted and the underlying foam deforms. At moderate speeds the shell can take one-third of the impact energy.

It distributes local forces from an impact:

rigid objects like stone or a projecting beam can cause a skull fracture at low forces, the shell acts to distribute the force of such impact eliminating the risk of penetration.

It allows sliding on road surfaces: the shell being rigid and having a convex shape allows the helmet to slide along a road surface without there being an excessive force.

It protects the face and temples:

full-face helmet is beneficial in protecting the face and jaw. The chin bar of such helmets contain rigid foam to absorb energy for direct blows on the chin, prevent facial bone fractures and prevent the lower part of the forehead and temple being struck.

The Protective Padding

this is a molding of polystyrene beads or polyurethane foam. It provides a stopping distance for the head. The foam can compress by 90% during an impact, although it recovers partially afterwards. But this helps increase the stopping distance thus reducing the peak deceleration of the head. It also protects as much as possible of the head. In addition to this there is a layer of comfort padding to provide comfort to the wearer.

Proper Strapping System: It is essential to wear a well-fitting helmet for the effective working of chinstrap system. To test if the helmet fits your head properly, tightly fasten the chinstrap and then pull helmet off forward by gripping the rear and then pulling. The strap must be threaded correctly so that the buckle locks the strap when it is pulled from the chin side. The strap must be pulled as tight as is bearable under the chin.

Every person, above four years of age, driving or riding or being carried on a motorcycle of any class or description shall, while in a public place, wear

protective headgear conforming to such standards as may be prescribed by the Central Government. Provided that the provisions of this section shall not apply to a person who is a Sikh, if, while driving or riding on the motorcycle, in a public place, he is wearing a turban. Provided further that the Central Government may by rules provide for measures for the safety of children below four years of age riding or being carried on a motorcycle.

Explanation — "Protective headgear" means a helmet which:-

By virtue of its shape, material and construction, could reasonably be expected to afford to the person driving or riding on a motorcycle a degree of protection from injury in the event of an accident; and

Is securely fastened to the head of the wearer by means of straps or other fastenings provided on the headgear.

Police officers of the rank of assistant commissioner, inspector and sergeant were present at the event to emphasise the need to follow traffic rules.


A power-point presentation was shown to the students and it was followed by an interactive session.




Faculty Exchange Programme Report 2020


The faculty exchange programme is a mutual, inter-institutional agreement for the exchange of expertise and services with each other.




Faculty Exchange Programme Report 2022
