Distinctiveness:

The following traits underline our college's distinctiveness:

Specialized Academic Programs: The PDEA's Law College typically provides the BALLB (5 years) and LLB (3 years) degrees. The Institute also provides specialised and specialist academic diploma courses in labour law, tax law, and cyber law in addition to these courses.
